Scripture: Psalm 34 Goodness Matthew 7:7-11

Big Question: How do we know that God is good?

Big Idea: God's goodness **satisfies** our longings, is always **available**, and is **incapable** of failing.

Satisfies v. 1-7 Available V. 18 Incapable of failing 19-22

Introduction: *Incomplete Ingredients*

• V. 1-7 A declaration and an invitation-look for goodness not in your circumstances but in your God.

The Imperatives of the Goodness of God

- V. 8 *Taste* and *see* Taste and see that the Lord is good in the deepest troubles and to the poorest man
- V.9 *Fear* Fear the Lord you holy, you set apart people and experience His abundant provision.
- V. 10-12 *Come* Come and obey the Lord and see that this is your best life now, tomorrow, and for all eternity.
- V. 13 *Keep* Keep your smallest part from being your biggest enemy. James 3:5-10
- V. 14 *Turn* Turn from your own ways and seek the goodness of the Lord.

Conclusion: *Never imagine that a praying heart pleads to a deaf God.* Charles Spurgeon
