- V. #1 How Jacob got to the land of Canaan.

 - Genesis 11: God creates the nations.
 - Genesis 12: God calls His people.
 - Genesis 13-36 God conceives His blessing to the nations.

How the family line lives in Canaan

- V. #2-4 A family line of favoritism.
- V. #5-7 A family line of foolish behavior.
- V. #8-11 A family line that will fulfill God's plans.
