Introduction: Martinsville and Moses

The Rejection of Pharaoh

- Pharaoh had an attitude problem
- Pharaoh had an **acknowledgement** problem
- Pharaoh had an arrogance problem

The Dejection of Moses

- Moses is questioning God's person.
- Moses is questioning God's purpose.
- Moses is questioning God's power.

The Confirmation of God

- **Refresh** your perspective to see what God is doing amidst your suffering.
- Relive ways God has already revealed Himself to you.
- **Recognize** that the Gospel is not only for unbelievers.
- Remember that God is concerned for you.
- **Remind** yourself that justice will come.

Applications: How do I take possession of this message and live it out in my life?

- Turn to God for deliverance.
- Trust that God remembers.
- Take the next step in faith.
