**Introduction:** *Weeds and Bushes*

#### **What God Expects Moses to Say**

- He has **watched** over you in your misery.
- He will **work** your way out of your misery.
- He will have Egyptians **willingly** give you all you need for your journey.

#### **Moses' Excuses**

- Who am I?
- Who are you?
- What if Israel does not listen to me?
- I am not an eloquent speaker.
- Send someone else.

#### **God's Examples of Power**

- The burning but not consumed bush
- The voice of God
- The name of God
- The Staff
- The Spots

**Applications:** How do I take possession of this message and live it out in my life?

- God made you just the way that He needs you to be.
- God does not leave you as you are.
- God is who He has been and always will be.
